



2017 TENNESSEE ESTHETICS CONTESTANT PACKET

This packet contains important information for all contestants. Included is a detailed schedule, detailed task descriptions, and listing of point values per task.

The purpose of the esthetics contest is to evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of esthetics.

The 2017 Theme for Fantasy Makeup is "Flora and / or Fauna" to utilize nature based concepts of animal or plant life or a combination.

The contest will follow all rules as outlined in the 2017-18 SkillsUSA Esthetic Technical Standards

Schedule

Monday April 10, 2017

- Orientation and Competition / Models are not required to attend
- 12:00 p.m. (noon) to 4:00 p.m.
 - Orientation, contest review, question/answer session (30 minutes)
 - All questions are to be directed to the Technical Committee from contestants, not advisors, models, or observers.
 - Turn in resume and written description of theme for fantasy make-up application
 - Review of finalized schedule, all official contest rules and question / answer session.

 - Oral Assessment

TASKS / TIME LIMITS / SCORING

- Written Examination: Contestants will have 30 minutes to complete a 50 question assessment based on knowledge of esthetics. This will be administered prior to the conference. (100 points)
- Kit Check: Contestants will be prepared to present to the judges all required items and supplies as instructed. A complete listing can be found in the 2017-18 SkillsUSA Esthetics Technical Standards (100 points)
- Oral Communication: Contestants will deliver a 2-3 minute oral communication presentation on the contestants interpretation and/or approach to the yearly theme for fantasy makeup. (100 points)
- Facial massage: Contestants will perform a facial cleansing massage on a live model including all necessary pre-and post-service procedures within a 15-minute time limit. (150 points)
- Basic Facial: Contestants will perform a basic facial service on a live model including all necessary pre- and post-service procedures within a 30-minute time limit. (150 points)
- Beauty Makeup Application: Contestants will perform a daytime or evening cosmetic application on a live model including all necessary pre- and post-service procedures with a 45 minute time limit. (125 points)
- Fantasy Make-up Application: Contestants will turn in a one-page typewritten written description of the Fantasy Makeup theme interpretation at the contestant orientation. Contestants will perform a fantasy make-up application on a live model including all necessary pre- and post- service procedures within a 60 minute time limit. (125 points)

- Sterilization and Sanitation Procedures / Safety: Proper measures of client protection will be monitored throughout all performance skills. (150 points)
- Resume and / or clothing penalties may result in point deductions, this includes all times the contest is being held and applies to contestants and models

Special Notice

- Contest updates as listed at <http://www.skillsusa.org/compete/updates.shtml> will be followed. Please continue to check these on a regular basis.

Of special interest should be the following:

- Clothing requirements are required during the orientation and skill contest times
 - Models are only required to attend on Tuesday April 11, 2017
 - Contestant and model clothing requirements should be followed
 - As listed in 2017-18 SkillsUSA Technical standards
 - Or according to any other official SkillsUSA resource for the current year
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 - For models: plain black t-shirt, black dress slacks, black or skin tone hose and black closed toe shoes
 - Models and contestants must have hair pulled away from the face
 - Models must arrive with a clean cosmetic free face
 - Other than during the Fantasy Makeup Portion of the contest, no piercings are allowed (Only to be applied during the time allowed for prop application)
- Written descriptions will only be accepted at the contestant orientation. Failure to turn this in will result in a 10 point deduction in the Fantasy Makeup scoring.
- All towels must be basic salon size, white and without holes or stains. Contestant should be prepared to donate 2 towels to be used in steamer on Monday April 10. Standard salon size is approximately 15" x 25" to 16" x 28", large or small towels will result in a 5 point deduction.
- Decontamination supplies for hand equipment and implements must be EPA approved and in original manufacturer's packaging.
- Blood spill kit must have a properly labeled bio-hazard bag.
- Kit checks and oral assessments will be done immediately following the orientation session at the Tennessee SkillsUSA Competition; please be prepared.

- Penalties will be taken for contestants wearing nail polish or artificial nails; and contestants and models wearing of jewelry (only exception is wedding band) or facial piercings.
- Cell phones are not allowed (by contestants or models) during any portion of the contest, this includes on-site breaks.
- Time will be provided to add final props following the judging of the fantasy makeup application.
- Time will not be provided to remove the beauty makeup application. This may be done during the allotted time of fantasy makeup application at the contest site.
- Props for the Fantasy portion will only be permitted following the judging. Hair ornaments, jewelry, prosthetics or wigs may only be used during the time allowed for prop application.

The technical committee will supply:

1. Tables (for facial performance)
2. Chairs (for models)
3. Small table for products
4. Towel steamers
5. Water (not a water container)

Contestants will supply:

1. Items necessary for basic facial and massage skills
 - a. Cleanser
 - b. Toner
 - c. Moisturizer
 - d. Mask
 - e. Massage cream
2. Bowl
3. All other items listed in the technical standards

All Rules will be followed as listed in the SkillsUSA 2017-18 Technical Standards for Esthetics.
