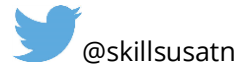

What is SkillsUSA?

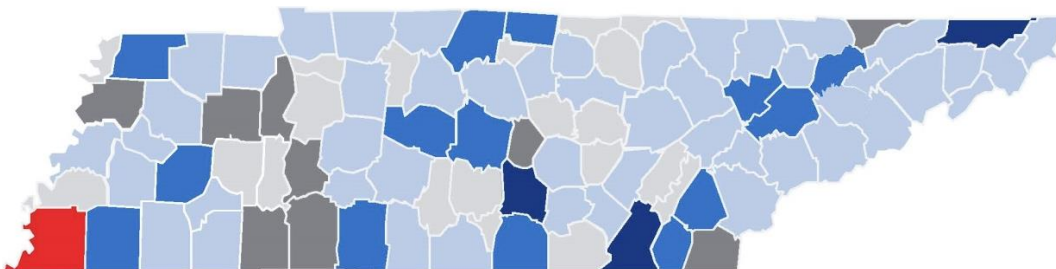
